VOCAL MUSIC (SOLO)

The competitions in Vocal Music will be conducted in the following two categories:

1. Vocal Music-Classical.
2. Vocal Music-Traditional Folk.
 - ❖ The duration of the performance will be 4–6 minutes.
 - ❖ Costumes, settings, props and properties should relate to the presentation.
 - ❖ Any student/teacher can play instrument as accompanist with the main participant.
 - ❖ Professional and commercial tracks are not allowed.

 - ❖ Accompanying musical instruments can be played by teachers/ student.
 - ❖ For traditional folk music, only indigenous musical instruments are allowed.
 - ❖ Electronic/programmed musical instrument will not be allowed.
