C I R C U L A R

Sub: "Merit Based Award and recognition of High Performance in the Board Exams of SSC and HSSC in the State of Goa" for Students belonging to SCs Community - Year 2018 -19.

It is informed to all the Heads of the Educational Institutions that, applications of students belonging to Scheduled Castes Communities in case of above mentioned scheme may be obtained. A list of students accompanied with duly filled Application Form and copies of requisite documents such as Caste Certificate, Educational Certificate(s), Income certificate, Birth Certificate/proof as Goan Origin, Bank Account of student, Residence Certificate, Aadhar Card and Pre-Receipt duly signed by the student shall be submitted to this Directorate along with the details of the students given in the enclosed proforma (Annexure "A") in the form of **Hard copy** as well as **Soft copy** compulsorily failing which applications will not be entertained. The Applications should reach this Directorate on or before **31st August 2019** positively duly completed in all respect and supported with all the documents prescribed under the scheme. **Incomplete applications & without soft copy will not be entertained.**


Eligibility Criteria:

The following is the eligibility criteria for the Scheduled Caste students' who has passed Xth & XIIth March 2019 Exam:

- a) Students securing marks in the range (between 50% to 59.99%) will be given a financial award of Rs.5000/-.
- b) Students securing marks in the range (between 60% to 69.99%) will be given a financial award of Rs.8000/-.
- c) Students securing marks in the range (between 70% to 74.99%) will be given a financial award of Rs.10,000/-.
- d) Students securing 75% marks and above will be given a financial award of Rs.15000/-.

Income limit for above is less than Rs.2.00 lakh.

Further, Government of Goa will felicitate the students of SCs Communities in public function in recognition of their high performance in the SSC and HSSC Exams respectively. Under the scheme amongst the SC students, First Five Rank Holders of SSC, First Five Rank Holders of HSSC Board Exams (separately for all the Streams of Science, Commerce, Arts and Vocational) will be felicitated. A Certificate of Appreciation will be given at the time of felicitation and a financial award of Rs.20,000/- will be transferred electronically in the Bank Account of the Rank Holder Student. There are no restrictions on the basis of income ceiling.
